
Tully/Mission Beach Road - Boat Ramp signage issue

Directional Signage for Feluga Turnoff during times of flooding


Thank you for your letter on behalf of the Mission Beach Community Association about detour directional signage for Feluga Road during times of flooding.

Please be advised that the department does not have permanent signage to advise motorists of detours in times of flooding. However, when a road becomes impassable, the police in conjunction the applicable maintenance steward of the particular road (Council or Main Roads), will make the necessary arrangements to erect the relevant temporary road closure signage.

In the case of a suitable detour around a flooded state controlled road, that decision is made by the local management authority and they are responsible for the appropriate temporary detour signage to direct certain vehicles onto a council road.


Cassowary Drive (Mission Beach to El Arish Road) – Walking track signage
