"We opened the building over the Easter break and had more than 100 inspections with the overwhelming response that Mission@Mission is the first luxury lock and leave residence in the region."

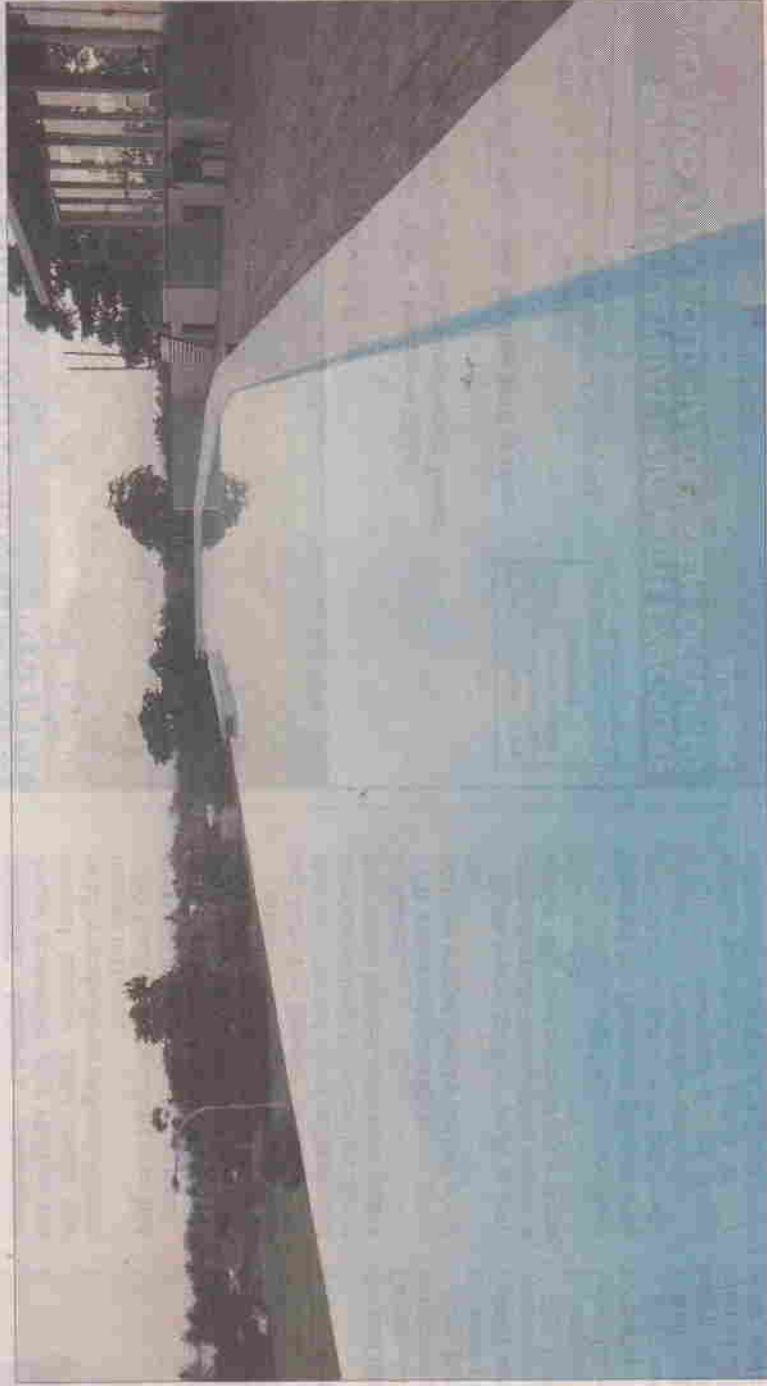
Features include basement car parking, video security access, a 29m swimming pool and landscaped stone walls.
